



Raised-Bed Community Garden

Sanburnol Park is home to the raised-bed community garden. Located in the south east corner of the park, these raised–beds make gardening easier for you to



plant, maintain and harvest your crops.

Returning gardeners have until March 1st to reserve their garden bed. New gardeners may reserve starting March 2nd.

One garden plot per household can be reserved by mail or in person at the Recreation Department.

There will be access to water, however, the gardens will be situated to receive regular watering from the park irrigation system. Barrels for waste and organic materials will be provided to encourage a clean garden area.— Mowed grass paths separate the gardens. You may use granular fertilizers and insecticidal soap for pest control. No aerosol or hose end sprayer fertilizers/ pesticides will be allowed.


