

# LAKE MICHIGAN TOUR

#### Day 1—June 18

This morning we start our journey, we will take comfort stops along the way. We will check out a historic **Menominee Logging Camp** and find some yummy **Klema's Sequins Cheese.** The late afternoon we will explore the Menominee, MI area and get our first real look at Lake Michigan. (L/D)

### Day 2—June 19

Today we will head to St. Ignace Mi, stopping along the way to see some amazing sights. Our stops today will include **Palms Book State Park** and **Castle Rock** for some amazing views. #### Day 3—June 20

We will head over the **Mackinac Bridge** today and catch our ferry to **Mackinac Island** for the day. Once on the island we will take a carriage tour of the island and have lunch at the **Grand Lodge.** After lunch you will have some time to explore the island on your own before catching the ferry back to the mainland. Our route to Petoskey will take us through the **Tunnel of Trees.** (B/L)

#### Day 4—June 21

Today we will check out **Castle Farms** built in 1918 by Albert Loeb, the acting President of Sears, Roebuck, and Co. as a model dairy farm, Loeb Farms was modeled after the stone barns and castles found in Normandy, France. **Sleeping Bear Dunes National Shoreline** is a stop you won't want to miss. (B/L)

#### Day 5—June 22

It's an up close day with Lake Michigan as we cross on the Badger Ferry. The S.S. *Badger* is the last coal-fired passenger steamship in operation in the United States. There is so much to do on the Ferry—Badger Bingo, shopping, movies, a museum and of course a café. Landing in Manitowoc, WI and head north to **Sturgeon Bay** for our visit to Door County. Tonight we will enjoy a traditional Door **County Fish Boil**. (B/D)

#### Day 6—June 23

Today we will take a boat tour on Lake Michigan departing from **Fish Creek.** Lunch will be on your own in town and the afternoon is yours to explore the unique shops. (B/D)

#### Day 7—June 24

Today we will say good bye to Lake Michigan and head for Spring Lake Park. (B)
